Rocky Mountain Cycling Club Presents Huntsville 100

Saturday August 20

Route leaves Huntsville (4900 ft.) and climbs up Scenic Byway 39 for 25 miles, cresting the ridge at 8900 ft. The course follows a ridgeline 5 miles through rolling peaks.

Metric 100 riders turn around just past Monte Cristo campground and begin their descent back into Huntsville. The 100 Mile course continues east on SR 39 another 18 miles, descending to a turnaround in Woodruff (6300 ft.) at mile 49. 100 Milers must re-crest the Monte Cristo peak and then descend back to Huntsville.

Location: Take I-15 north to Ogden, exit on 12th Street exit go east on hy 39 to Hunstville. The start / finish will be at Hunstville Town Park just south of 100 South.
