Public Transportation: If you are downtown, the UTA bus is a great option to get up to the Hill. Route 500 will take you right to the East Building's front door! The Capitol is in the Downtown Free Zone and buses run every 30 minutes. You will find the bus and TRAX schedules, routes, and trip planner at their website www.rideuta.com
