Whereas, According to the Annals of Internal Medicine, women are three times more likely to be homicide victims and men are four times more likely to commit suicide when firearms are within reach²:

Whereas, According to surveys, three-quarters of sexual violence is committed by people the victims know³; therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Women's State Legislative Council of Utah is opposed to HB 198: Concealed Carry Amendments, which would reduce the concealed carry permit age to 18.
